### Inclusion criteria

- Patients of all ages
- In- and outpatient context
- Patients with (PCR) confirmed SARS-CoV-2
- Available basic medical information including patients' history, an initial blood sample and outcome data
- Possibility to include patients incapable of giving consent: anonymous data collection where no informed consent necessary
